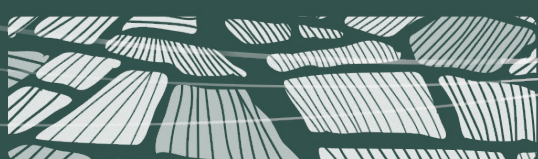
THE TERROIRS OF BOURGOGNE AND MÂCON PLUS A GEOGRAPHICAL DENOMINATION

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Régionales appellations represent 53% of Bourgogne's total wine production. Often considered a singular category, they in fact offer more diversity than first meets the eye. Amongst the *Régionales* appellations, Bourgogne and Mâcon plus geographical denomination lead this notion of terroir. With stricter production regulations and plot delimitation, the wines are able to express the distinct characteristics of their birthplace.
